Seminar One: October 8, 2011

Learning Stations for the Preschool Child: CBK K2 C2 13

Learning Stations are separate areas set aside in your classroom, equipped with teacher developed learning activities and materials specifically designed for small group interactive education. Learning Stations can serve to motivate hands on learning, build and reinforce basic skills, foster independent learning, build peer cooperation and promote children's self-esteem.

Kindergarten...Ready or Not Here I Come: CBK K1 C3 A1

This workshop will discuss, as well as define, kindergarten readiness and why it is often an important consideration. We will look into the developmental areas addressed when discussing readiness, as well as explore parent and teacher concepts of readiness. We will also address risk factors that may affect a successful kindergarten experience.

Come on Let's Read: CBK K2 C2 13

This workshop will explore the link between literacy and school performance as well as later life success. Focus will be on the benefits of reading aloud, tips for reading aloud and choosing various books to enhance a child's depth of learning.

Media Effects on Young Children: CBK K3 C2 31

This workshop will explore the staggering statistics concerning TV/media use in the home and how such media exposure can affect the young child's cognitive, emotional, physical and social development.

Seminar Two: October 22, 2011

Understanding Confidentiality: CBK K8 C3 94

Participants are provided with a presentation on the issue of confidentiality as it relates to personnel issues, clients, and agency records. The focus is on the "need to know" approach.

Court Orders and the Release of Children: CBK K3 C3 35

This workshop will examine the most common forms of Custody Orders and their impact upon the early childhood setting. We will review the basic tenants of "Shared Custody"/ "Joint Custody" and "Temporary Custody Orders" and other typical custodial arrangements.

Supervision of Children in Early Care and Education: CBK K2 C3 21

This workshop will focus on the supervision of children in the early childhood setting with particular emphasis on PA DPW Licensing regulations and expectations.

Mandated Reporting of Suspected Child Abuse and Neglect: CBK K8 C2 94

This workshop will help child care providers understand their roles as mandated reporters of suspected child abuse and neglect. Discussion will include the mandated reporters right of anonymity, proper documentation of a report, penalties for failure to report suspicions under this mandate and insulation from liability when reports are unfounded.

Seminar Three: November 12, 2011

Are You a Professional?: CBK K6 C3 61

Participants will be engaged in an interactive discussion to define "profession" and to reflect on how they can act personally to promote a professional air.

Harmony in the Workplace: CBK K5 C3 51

This workshop will focus on the importance of getting along with co-workers in the workplace. We will explore the benefits of a harmonious workplace in terms of productivity, morale and staff performance.

Communication Skills: CBK K5 C2 51

This workshop focuses on the development of good communication skills. We will address how to train your staff to share information. We will also look at what is required to become a better communicator.
